Parent / Player Covenant

In order for Covenant United Methodist Church to effectively provide a wholesome environment that will assure the spirit of fair play, good sportsmanship and be honouring to God, it is necessary for all parents, and participants to be using the same guidelines. So please read and follow these guidelines.

1. Appropriate Use of Language

The parents, players and spectators should never use the Lord's name in vain and should never use language that could be considered foul or unclean.

2. Expressions of Concern Toward the Officials

The parents, players and spectators should never yell at or belittle the officials. The appropriate way to express your concern about and official is to speak to the Director Recreation.

3. Inappropriate Behaviour / Poor Sportsmanship

A player who expresses inappropriate behaviour or actions resulting in a red card, ejection from game will incur loss of playing time and/or possible suspension from games or the team.

4. Ejection from Games

Players or teams ejected from games will be subject to review on whether they will be allowed to continue to play in the league.

5. Spectators Role

The parents, players and spectators should cheer for their team and that is all. They should avoid officiating for the officials and coaching for the coaches. No one should yell at each other or towards the other team. They should try to be a positive influence on their team. Your signature indicates that you agree to the terms above and it is required for you to be a member of a Covenant Team.
